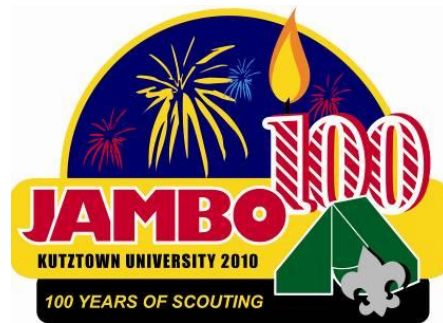

SCHEDULE:

Friday, May 14 – Check In and setup for Cub Scout, Boy Scout and Venturing camping begins at 5:00 p.m. Scoutmaster and Cubmaster meetings are scheduled to begin at 8:30 p.m.

Saturday, May 15 – Opening Ceremonies begin at 8:45 a.m. Open program between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Lunch scheduled from 12:00 noon to 1:30 p.m. Program areas remain open during lunch. Dinner between 5:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. with a special evening program scheduled to start at 7:00 p.m.

Sunday, May 18 – Church Services and Mass will begin at 9:00 a.m. followed by designated-area clean up and campsite cleanup.

CAMPSITE ORGANIZATION:

For camping, JAMBO100 will be divided into three large sub-camps. Boy Scouts, Venturers, and Cub Scout Family Camping will all have their own large designated camping areas. All camping will have some space requirements and will be on a first come, first served

basis. On-site camping services for sanitation, water, trash, and security/fire protection will be provided. NO FIRES are permitted.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS:

Inflatable-attraction midways, music bands, petting zoos, magicians, various sports activities, and climbing walls are among a few of the activities that are being planned JAMBO100.



BOY SCOUT PROGRAM:

Last Jambo we had some great activities. For JAMBO100, we'll have even more fantastic programs! So far, plans include: a special Friday-night activity exclusively for Boy Scouts, a contest for eating two hotdogs the fastest, launching projectiles from a trebuchet, a C.O.P.E. Course (low elements), sports activities, shooting sports, games, select merit badges and many more exciting programs that will make JAMBO100 a great Scouting event. Programs will focus on fun for both Scout patrols and individual Scouts alike.
