Webelos Naturalist/Forester Event

Webelos will fulfill requirements 3, 6, 7, and 8. Participants will learn about the many ways that the balance of nature is affected on a daily basis. They will also learn about the many things that can be done to ensure respect for nature. Webelos will be asked to compare and contrast the wild animals from the Nature Hike to the wild animals at the Zoo and explain why zoos are so important to ensure the survival of certain animal species.

Webelos will be fulfilling pin requirements 2, 3, 4, and 6. Learn how to identify trees and flowers common to the area as well as how both wildlife and humans use them. Examine the growth rings of a tree stump and see how the rings tell its life history. Conservation Education staff will also present an Animal Encounter featuring forest animals and a customized Zoo tour highlighting our forest animals from around the world.
