Eagle Scout Award



Venturers and Sea Scouts can continue to earn Eagle in a Crew or Ship if they are:

- **First Class Scout or higher**
- **Earned as a Boy Scout or Varsity Scout**
- **Leadership position are Crew or Ship positions**
- **All Eagle Requirements remain the same.**

Boards of Review

Scout Ranks must have a Board of Review

May be troop, team, or crew / ship Review

Follow “Venturing Board of Review Guide”

No advisors, assistants, relatives, or Direct Leaders

Purposes

Work has been learned and completed

What kind of experience did the youth have?

Encourage advancement to next rank

Not an examination, 15 minutes max

Eagle board follows council procedures

Discovery and Pathfinder Board of Review

- **Consists of Crew Members Peers**
- **Chaired by Crew President unless Crew President is candidate then the Crew Vice President is Chair**
- **No Required Number of Board members but President and 2 members is appropriate.**
- **Chair select other Board members from Crew.**
- **2 Adult Crew Members preferably Crew Committee are non voting members of the Board.**
- **Crew Advisor and associate Advisors are not members of the board of review, but may be present as observers, and they may serve as one or both of the registered adults present.**
- **At no time should there be more adults then Venturers present.**



BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA

Venturing Summit Award Board of Review

- The board of review, should be a celebratory experience, where the fun, adventures, and benefits of the program are recounted much like stories around the campfire or the dining table
- Summit Award board of review is chaired by a representative of the local council or district advancement committee.
- The chair may cast a vote
- The board is composed of Venturers, adult volunteers, and, if possible, a representative of the community who is well respected and who may add an element of prestige to the meeting.
- The board of review must consist of at least five, but no more than six, members. At least one half of the members, excluding the chair, must be Venturers currently participating in the program.
