Crews will return to base camp each night, except for overnight backpacking treks. Crews will do their own cooking in crew fashion. All cooking equipment is provided. Each Crew will complete a service project at camp, or in the local community. Friday afternoon is camp-wide games. Evening programs will provide social time and group activities. Crews will sleep in either cabins or tents, as requested on a first reserved basis. The Leaders Guide will be available by September 30, 2015 which will provide full details for the camp operation.

How to Register

Registration for the 2016 camp session is now open! The base will operate for four weeks in 2016, offering 6 trek opportunities each session. To register please visit the Lumpkin website and complete the online form, then submit it with your Crew's \$200 deposit. (Deposit counts toward total Crew Fee)

Crew size must be a minimum of 8 youth and adults.

Crew payments will be due in January, March and May. All fees are refundable until May 15, 2016.

All crew members will complete the same trek, and supporting adult leadership must participate with Crew members. Crews with more than 12 members can participate in multiple treks. If you have an individual Venturer who wants to attend LAB please contact us to discuss the options.

Who: Lumpkin Adventure Base is operated by the Daniel Boone Council, Boy Scouts of America in Asheville, North Carolina.

What: LAB is America's first Venturing Camp. Dedicated to serving Venturing Scouts and their units.

When: Starting in the summer of 2016! LAB is open for now for weekend events, the High Adventure Base will begin operation in June 2016. Reservations are on a first come first serve basis and camp is expected to sell out by January 31, 2016. Make your Crew reservation today!

Where: The base is located in Macon County, south of Franklin NC. It is 117 acres and is surrounded by Nantahala National Forest. Our location also provides the perfect spot to experience the multitude of outdoor activities available in Western Carolina and North Georgia.

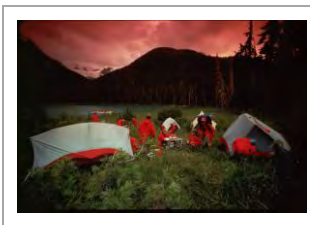

Adventure



Start with horseback riding and geocaching. Tuesday is filled with Zip Lines and COPE. Wednesday morning is shooting sports, followed by an overnight backpacking trip. Raft the Nantahala on Friday morning and finish your week with the camp-wide games. **\$500 per person**

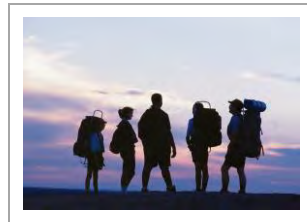

Rivers



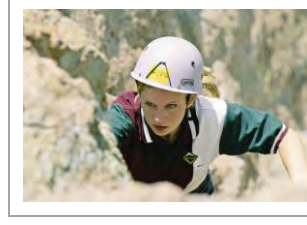

Afoot



Four days and three nights of backpacking in one of the most diverse ecological systems on earth. Choose from a variety of trails and distances. Raft the Nantahala River on Friday and compete in the Friday camp games to complete this trek. **\$350 per person**

First complete the Lumpkin High Ropes course and basic climbing lessons, then move on to climb live rock for two days. Thursday is packed with Zip Line and Cope Course. Raft the Nantahala River on Friday and compete in the Friday camp games to complete this trek. **\$500 per person.**
